

Day 244 Jerusalem during “Al-Aqsa Flood” Operation

June 6, 2024



On the 244th day of "Al-Aqsa Flood Operation", the "alleged Temple groups" announced an increase in the number of intruders into Al-Aqsa, and raids on the mosque continued during the two periods of raids, and raids on towns and neighborhoods in the city of Jerusalem continued.

The "alleged Temple groups" said that 37,000 settlers had stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque since the beginning of the year, confirming that the number of those storming Al-Aqsa had increased compared to the previous year.

The statistical groups issued the statistics on Thursday, the day after the anniversary of the occupation of Jerusalem and Al-Aqsa. More than 1,600 extremists, including current and former ministers and Knesset representatives, stormed Al-Aqsa. They raised Israeli flags inside, prayed, sang, and sang the “Israeli national anthem” in the mosque. They performed collective prostration and were able for the first time to bring in "Tefillin wraps” designated for biblical prayer and rituals.

The daily raids on Al-Aqsa continued, and 237 extremist settlers and Jewish students stormed the mosque, guarded by the occupation forces.

The daily incursions into Al-Aqsa take place through the Dung Gate, the keys of which have been controlled by the occupation authorities since the occupation of Jerusalem.

Raids

The occupation authorities and intelligence continued to storm neighborhoods and towns in the city of Jerusalem, and set up checkpoints in the streets.

Courts

The lawyers of the Wadi Hilweh Information Center – Jerusalem, Firas Al-Jabrini and Siraj Abu Arafa, explained that the “Magistrate Court” decided to release 8 young men who were

arrested during the settlers' march in Jerusalem, on the condition of house arrest for a period of 5 days, while the detention of 3 others was extended until next Monday.

On Thursday, the forces also arrested a merchant from the Old City of Jerusalem.
